FRIDAY, JUNE 9

- AM **One 55-passenger motor coach** arrives at **Venice High School**; begin loading
1 Indian Avenue, Venice, FL 34285
- AM Depart for **Tampa International Airport** (*77 miles; 1 ½ hours allotted for drive time*)
- AM Arrive at **Tampa International Airport**

Upon arrival Begin check-in process and head through security. Anyone 18 years and older should have **REAL ID driver's license, REAL ID State ID, or passport** (REAL ID will be required in the near future). Anyone 17 years or younger is asked to bring a School ID for identification purposes. Minors are not expected to have REAL ID identification. Keep them handy throughout check-in and security check-in.

- 11:30 AM Arrive at a **Midtown Manhattan hotel**; store luggage at the front desk
- 12:00 PM Depart for **Battery Park** via subway

- 12:30 PM Board the **Staten Island Ferry**
Admire the skyscrapers and bridges of Lower Manhattan as you pull away from the dock. While on deck, enjoy the perfect view of the Statue of Liberty and Ellis Island.
- 1:30 PM Walk as a group to **Brookfield Place**
230 Vessey Street, New York, NY 10281
- En route: Walk through the **Financial District** and **Wall Street**
See the Oculus, New York Stock Exchange, the Federal Reserve, Charging Bull Statue, Trinity Church, and walk the path of the 200 ticker-tape parades that took place in NYC.
- 2:00 PM Enjoy lunch at **Brookfield Place – Hudson Eats** (student cost)
Hudson Eats is a dining terrace featuring fast-casual concepts from 14 chef-driven eateries including Blue Ribbon Sushi Bar, Umami Burger, and Dos Toros Taqueria.
- 3:00 PM Visit the **9/11 Memorial**
180 Greenwich Street, New York, NY 10007
*This 16-acre site features two enormous waterfalls and reflecting pools, each about an acre in size, set within the footprints of the original twin towers. Its design conveys a spirit of hope and renewal, and creates a contemplative space separate from the usual sights and sounds of a bustling metropolis. *Admission to the museum is not included.*
- 4:00 PM Depart for **Chinatown & Little Italy** via subway
- 4:30 PM Enjoy dinner on your own (student cost) and time to explore **Chinatown & Little Italy**
The narrow streets at the heart of Chinatown and Little Italy feel utterly unlike the rest of New York City.
- 6:30 PM Depart for the hotel via subway
- 7:00 PM Arrive at the hotel; check in and rest after a long day!

Located in the heart of Midtown Manhattan, it is known for its big Christmas tree and ice skating in winter, Today Show concerts, Radio City Music Hall, and Saturday Night Live. - Check out: **5th Avenue**
See the famous high-end shops on 5th Avenue. You can find Chanel, Gucci, Saks on 5th, Ralph Lauren, Tommy Hilfiger, and much more!

- Explore the **Herald Square** area
Herald Square is home to the Flagship of the Macy's department store chain, Empire State Building, and Madison Square Garden. A short walk away is the new Harry Potter New York store in the Flat Iron District.
- Explore **Greenwich Village**
Greenwich Village is NYC's neighborhood of artists. Here you will see a far more quaint side of Manhattan. In Greenwich Village, you can visit famed Washington Square Park and see the exterior of the "Friends" Apartment (90 Bedford Street).
- Explore **Chelsea Market** and walk the **High Line**
The High Line is a public park built on a historic freight rail line elevated above the streets. It runs from Ganesvoort Street in the Meatpacking District to West 34th Street, between 10th and 12th Avenues. If you choose to walk the High Line, be sure to wear comfortable walking shoes. Below the High Line is Chelsea Market, a trendy shopping mall that is built in the former factory complex where the Oreo cookie was invented.
